Barrett operates the following web sites www.devicewatch.org, www.quackwatch.org, www.chirobase.org and 20 other web sites and has been a long time critic of chiropractic and a nemesis of alternative medicine such as the LLLT offering by Mac Beam, Inc. For years, Barrett has touted himself as a “medical expert” on his numerous web sites in healthcare.
